What is Identity Theft? Identity theft is the act of using someone's personal information and using the assumed identity to commit fraud or theft.

Identity theft is the single fastest growing crime in the nation - a \$50 billion a year industry that continues to expand its reach. According to a recent Federal Trade Commission survey, 30 million Americans - or 13.5% of all U.S. adults - fell victim to identity fraud.
