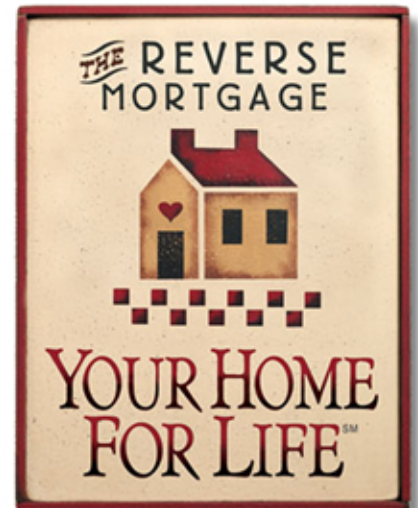

What is a Reverse Mortgage?

Reverse Mortgage (FHA-Insured) is a refinance loan ONLY for senior homeowners age 62 and older with sufficient equity. NO income qualification. No monthly mortgage payments. Minimal credit verification requirements. Repayment only at maturity event: death, property sale or relocation. Non-recourse: cannot owe more than the home's appraised value at the time of repayment. Homeowners retain full ownership of property. A reverse mortgage is simply a lien against the property. Come listen to this program to see if a Reverse Mortgage is right for you.
