

Clinical Trial Web Posting Reference Guide

Important Clinical Research Information that Affects Publishing

Ask yourself these three questions to determine if you need to post your trial:

- a) Are you currently or planning to be the Principal Investigator (PI) on a clinical study?
- b) Do you intend to publish data from that study?
- c) Has your study been registered with www.ClinicalTrials.gov?

If you answered yes to **A** and **B** and you are uncertain about **C**, please call Diana Naser, Director, Clinical Research Administration/Research Institute at 913-588-1242 for answers to questions and for assistance in registering your trial.

If you answered yes to **A** and **B** and *NO* to **C**, take the following steps to have your trial posted.

- 1) Complete the posting form located at:

- 2) E-mail Kevin Smilor in the Research Institute (ksmilor@kumc.edu)
- 3) If the study is sponsored by a pharmaceutical company and/or is bound by a confidentiality agreement or contract: obtain sponsor approval of the completed posting form.
