



Numbers Associated with a Clinical Study

- Protocol Number: A number assigned by the author, funding source, or sponsor of the study used to track the protocol. It is usually reflected on the front page of the protocol and often on the header.
- HSC Number: The number assigned by the KUMC Human Subjects Committee (also known as the IRB) for identification and tracking purposes.
- Grant Accounting Number: The number/letter assigned by KUMC grant accounting when an account is set up. This number is used to pay bills with PeopleSoft. It begins with a G followed by a series of numbers.
- RI Grant Accounting Number: The number used to pay bills with RI accounts. It consists of the modified grant accounting number.
- Study Billing Number: This is a number assigned by the Hospital and used by KUPI as well. It should be used to order tests/procedures that should be billed to the study and not the research subject. It begins with a 494.
