**How to become a fan:** You must be a fan to view this SoN information. To become a "fan" of the University of Kansas School of Nursing's page on Facebook, you must first have a personal Facebook profile. [www.facebook.com](http://www.facebook.com) will walk you through the process of creating a page. If you already have a page, find our page by entering "University of Kansas School of Nursing" in the Search box, located in the upper right corner. Our official page is University of Kansas School of Nursing, NOT KU School of Nursing. Once you have found the School's page, click on the "Become a Fan" at the top of the page, next to the name. - **Course-specific announcements:** Check the announcement pages of your **Angel course sites** on a regular basis. Faculty will post any announcements about particular courses to their individual course Angel sites.
- **Broadcast-emails** will be sent as needed from Dr. Rita Clifford and Dr. Debbie Ford (Student Affairs), Dr. Nelda Godfrey (Undergraduate Programs), and Dr. Cindy Teel (Graduate Programs). *Please check your kumc.edu email at least once a day!*
- **Text Messages:** KUMC has the capability to broadcast texts to the entire campus of users who have opted in to receive these emergency messages, not to individual schools, groups or classes. At this time we do *not* anticipate using texting for school- or class-specific announcements due to the system limitations. Should a flu-related emergency affect everyone at KUMC, then you would receive a text if you signed up to receive emergency texts Go to [mykumc.edu](http://mykumc.edu) to verify whether you have opted in for this service. *Remember, check your email daily.*
